14.1 Replacement for Typhoon Names (agenda item 14.1)

14.1.1 The Committee noted Macao, China provided PEILOU, PATUA and PAOCHOK as replacement names for LINFA; and CHOILONG, LONGYAMEN and PENHA as replacement names for VONGFONG.


14.1.2 The Committee noted the Philippines provided NARRA and KUSOG and GITING as replacement names for MOLAVE.

14.1.3 The Committee noted the Republic of Korea provided GAENARI, SORA and GARION as replacement names for GONI.

14.1.4 The Committee noted Viet Nam provided BANG-LANG, HOA-SIM and LUC-BINH as replacement names for VAMCO.


Replacement Tropical Cyclone Names from Macao, China

Replacement names for LINFA:

	Name	Meaning
1	Peilou	A common migratory bird in Macao.
2	Patuá	A Portuguese-based language originally spoken by the Macanese community in Macao.
3	Paochok	A handicraft firecracker industry that emerged in Macao in the 1950s and 1960s, contributing to Macao's economic development at the time.

Replacement names for VONGFONG:

	Name	Meaning
1	Choilong	A traditional festival activity in Macao that has been inscribed on the National Intangible Cultural Heritage List.
2	Longyamen	Another name of Macao in Ming Dynasty.
3	Penha	One of the Macao New Eight Scenic Spots. The Our Lady of Penha Chapel is located on the top of the hill and is listed in the Classified Immovable Properties.

3	GITING	/ 'gi.ting /	Heroism, great courage

No.	Replacement names	Meaning	Description
1	Bang-Lang	It is a species of medium-size woody native that widely distributed all over Viet Nam. It has purple flowers that bloom as a lovely indicator of the beginning of the summer. The scientific name is <i>Lagerstroemia speciosa</i> .	
2	Hoa - Sim	It is a species of bush native that is very popular in the hills and mountain of the Northern Viet Nam. It has purple flowers that bloom on the summer. The scientific name is <i>Rhodomyrtus tomentosa</i> .	
3	Luc - Binh	It is a an aquatic plant. It has purple flowers that bloom on all year. The scientific name is <i>Eichhoriaceae crassipes solms</i>
